Organ Donation

Organ donation is the process of giving an organ or a part of an organ for the purpose of transplantation into another person. Most of the organs used in transplants come from people who have suffered brain death as the result of an accident, heart attack, or stroke.

Organ Transplantation

Organ Transplantation is the transfer (engraftment) of human organs from a donor to a recipient with the aim of restoring their function

Who can donate?

All people of all ages should consider themselves potential organ and tissue donors. There are a few absolute exclusions (HIV positive, active cancer, systemic infection) and no strict upper or lower age limits. The condition of your organs is more important than age. Potential donors will be evaluated for suitability when the occasion arises.


Buddhism and Organ Donation
